- Very knowledgable and engaging. Determined to explain concepts to confused students. Friendly and open to students and runs the class as an open discussion with mutual respect between students and instructor. Correlates texts to projects well and is accessible to meet with students outside of class.

Responses

WEAKNESSES of the course and of the Instructor: -

Α

- Sometimes, Jordan moves a bit fast or spends a little bit too much time on a section especially on days of peer review.
- No major weaknesses besides perhaps a slight overload of material and reducing very complex topics to broad summary, which made it challenging to write essays on specific ideas.
- Sometimes feedback online made me feel bad, but it was usually alright. There was a lot of reading and writing to do, which I think helped me improve, but also it was a lot of work and a big course load (but he did tell us at the beginning that there was a lot of content, and also modified readings at the end to decrease course load).
- Sometimes the course would go by a bit quick with the course readings or material and the material at times can be very hard to go through so quickly due to its content.
- Schedule of class- as this class is a little bit text heavy, I would rather have this class spilt up its workload into smaller pieces. This class is fairly stressful for me because of the workload, and I think splitting up texts and class materials into smaller pieces (if possible) would definitely help
- The coursework is a bit heavy even when he reduces it
- The difficult readings were very long which made them a bit harder to get through.
- The classroom is on the fifth floor, so it was occasionally tiring to get to class because I'm out of shape.
- Jordan assigned a sometimes unreasonable amount of work and many of the texts were extremely difficult to work with.
- Spent too little time explaining some of the material
- I think that his level of understanding is much higher than ours and he can be a bit condescending at times.

- has really high expectations for us to understand some of these concepts super well.
- Availability Some assignments are a little far-fetched
